The CELAR JSSI is the thirteenth in a series of conferences bringing together researchers and practitioners from university, industry, and government, in thematic workshops on Information Security.

The goal of this conference is twofold: A didactic part is composed of tutorials or state of the art papers aimed at the IS operational community, and a more scientific part allows researchers to communicate recent results.

Submissions should specify explicitly: Paper category (tutorial/survey or regular paper) and title ; names and coordinates of authors ; email address of the corresponding author.

Submitted papers (in English or French) must not exceed 12 pages (A4 paper), and should include an abstract (maximum 15 lines). Accepted contributions will be published in the symposium proceedings.
